Things that connect Police Brutality and Poor Health Outcomes:

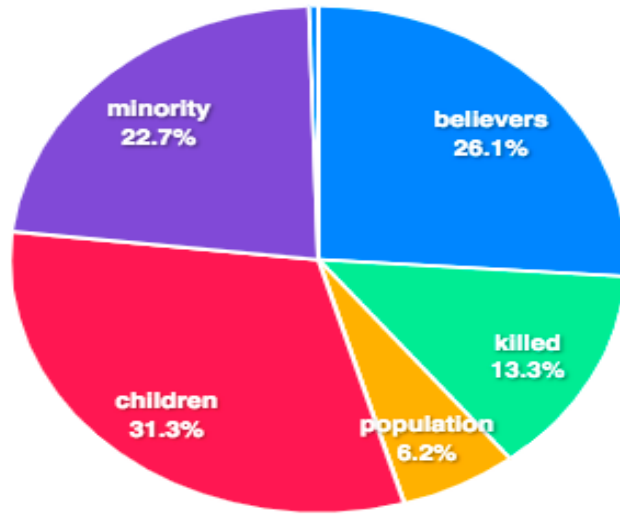
- > fatal injuries
- > adverse psychological responses
- > racist public reactions that cause stress
- > arrests, legal, medical, funeral bills that cause financial stress and strain

Statistics Key:

- B: 55% of people who believe police aren't properly trained
- K: 28% of African Americans killed
- P: 13% of the population is African Americans
- C: 66% of children killed were colored
- M: 44% of minority adults killed compared to children
- F: 1% of funding police

Punishments for Police in Some Cases:

- > desk jobs and removal of weapon upon investigation
- > murder charges
- > forced to resign and/or fired
